Statement of Fees & Financial Policy

We are aware that a quality independent school education is a major family investment. To help make a Wilson School education manageable and affordable, we offer a ten-payment option as well as a Tuition Assistance Program. We always will do our best to keep tuition reasonable through careful management of school resources and through our efforts to acquire alternate sources of income from extended day programs, summer programs and charitable giving. In return, we seek families who will place The Wilson School education as a first priority in their budgeting of financial resources, in their commitment of time and in their support of the Annual Giving Fund.

What are Wilson parents' responsibilities to the financial support of their child's education at Wilson?

- Make tuition payments by the due date.
- Contribute generously to the Annual Giving Fund.
- Contribute to a planned long-range giving program.
- Support when you can other fund-raising activities during the year.

Financial Policies

1. Enrollment Contracts apply to one school year only.
2. Tuition and other charges are to be paid on the date due.
3. Deposits must accompany the Enrollment Contract.
 - Non-refundable deposit for a returning student is \$750.
 - Non-refundable deposit for a new student is 10% of the tuition.

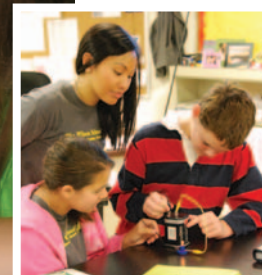
